
03:01 To consider and peruse the actions taken on the second IQAC meeting held on 8th Feb 2020.

The IQAC Director presented the actions taken on the suggestions made during the 2^{nt} IQAC meeting. The IQAC resolved to ratify the actions taken as presented and accepted the time requested for implementation of few suggestions.

03:02 To consider the performance of Institute in different functional areas like Academics, Research and Development, Industry Institute Interaction, Student Activities and Societal Responsibilities.

The Deans presented the performance of their functional domains in alignment with the AQAR criteria. The Committee has the following recommendations for further improvement

- AICTE Examinations Performance Indicators need to be adopted in the Examinations. Faculty training has been given during May - July 2020 regarding this along with CDIO Syllabus Design
- Target for Faculty publications may be increased to 6 / Faculty / Year and Department wise Dashboard may be prepared as a motivation factor.
- Number of Full time PhD scholars may be increased for improving publications and research projects
- Collaborative activities can be classified into academic and industry collaborations as per the requirement of NAAC Criteria 3.7
- R&D equipment cost may be included in capital expenditure. Purchase cost for Library resources need to be improved (min. 15Lakhs p.a.).
- List of students benefited by 100% fee waive may be prepared, as it is one of the criteria in NIRF ranking
- Weightage can be given in Faculty Performance Appraisal format for participating in content preparation for online platforms like ePatasala, swayam, etc
- Differences in weights have to be used in Faculty Performance Appraisal form based on the cadres like Professor, Associate Professor and Assistant Professor.
- New strategy has to be adopted for Student Satisfaction Survey (SSS) so as to get better marks in NAAC Cycle 2 accreditation
- Internal Academic Audit Reports and Action Taken Reports have to be shared in IQAC
 Meetings
- IQAC meeting presentation have to be streamlined in accordance with performance indicators



During the IQAC Meeting, the members had suggested the following points:

- 1. IQAC activities have to be formalized by benchmarking with A++ graded Institutes
- 2. Students may be asked to appear for CSIR examinations
- 3. Possibility of increasing the TCE proficiency scale and attainment level may be analyzed
- 4. Green audit and Energy Audit may be conducted annually
- 5. Initiative can be taken up for NAAC Reassessment in next year
